IELTS (The International English Language Testing System)

General Information

The ILETS is accepted by most Australian, British, Canadian and New Zealand academic institutions. American academic institutions are increasingly accepting IELTS for admissions purposes. The IELTS is offered in Myanmar at the British Council in Yangon.

The IELTS is jointly managed by The University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate (UCLES), The British Council and IDP Education Australia: IELTS Australia, so you can contact any of these organizations for more information about the test.

Note: there is an academic version and a general proficiency version. If you are applying to universities, you must take the academic version.

Description of the Test

The IELTS consists of 4 sections and takes 3 hours to complete:

Listening	4 sections	40 items	30 minutes
Academic Reading	3 sections	40 items	60 minutes
Academic Writing	2 tasks	150/250 wds	60 minutes
Speaking			10-15 minutes

Scoring

Candidates receive a separate score for each section and an overall score. Scores are given on a band scale from 1 to 9, with one representing almost no English ability and 9 representing total fluency.
