Institute of Human Rights and Peace Studies, Mahidol University, Thailand

The Master of Human Rights and Democratization - Asia Pacific (APMA, formerly MHRD) program is hosted at Mahidol University's Institute of Human Rights and Peace Studies (IHRP). With partial funding from the European Commission, the APMA partnership of five universities has graduated over 140 students from Asia Pacific and beyond. The degree has contributed much to the capacity of emerging leaders in the Asia Pacific region who protect and promote human rights and democracy.

Study at the IHRP for the first semester and continue the program at one of four partner universities in Indonesia, Nepal, Sri Lanka, or the Philippines. The program costs approximately €6,000. **20 scholarship positions are available** for qualified applicants from Asia Pacific.
