MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

1) Resume

Please include the following information in not more than 2 pages:

- Personal information: e.g. full name, address, nationality, education, languages spoken
- Current and previous employment and education history

2) Written submission

To better understand your motivations for applying to this Fellowship, please cover the points below in a written submission (300-600 words).

Points to cover in your submission:

- What is your professional background, experiences and expertise related to corporate social responsibility (CSR)?
- Why are you applying to this fellowship, and what do you plan to do with the new knowledge and experience acquired after 1 year of learning?
- Briefly describe your understanding of how responsible business practices, or corporate social responsibility (CSR), can contribute to ASEAN's sustainable development
- Indicate if you are also applying for the partial scholarship (covering all costs except for flights)

3) Provide at least 2 referees

One of the referees must be your current employer, the other either a previous employer, academic supervisor or community leader whom you have worked with (e.g. from civil society, religious organisation, or other voluntary commitments). Please provide us with their **names, titles and contact information**.

SUPPLEMENTARY / OPTIONAL DOCUMENTS

You may also include the following optional documents to strengthen your application:

4) Support / endorsement letter(s)

From the referees you have provided in 3).

5) Certificates, awards or other transcripts

This could include proof of excellence in community service, leadership, academia, businesses, etc.
