What is the IB Diploma Programme?

The IB Diploma Programme is one of the most well regarded and widely known secondary school qualifications in the world, and is recognized by the world's leading universities. It is designed as an academically challenging and balanced programme of education with final examinations that prepare students, normally aged 16 to 18, for success at university and in life beyond.

IB Diploma Programme students study six courses at a higher level or standard level. Students must choose one subject from each of groups 1 to 5, thus ensuring breadth of experience in languages, social studies, the experimental sciences and mathematics. The sixth subject may be an arts subject chosen from group 6, or the student may choose another subject from groups 1 to 5.

In addition the programme has three core requirements that are included to broaden the educational experience and challenge students to apply their knowledge and understanding.

The extended essay is a requirement for students to engage in independent research through an in-depth study of a question relating to one of the subjects they are studying.

Theory of knowledge is a course designed to encourage each student to reflect on the nature of knowledge by critically examining different ways of knowing (perception, emotion, language, and reason) and different kinds of knowledge (scientific, artistic, mathematical, historical).

Creativity, action and service requires that students actively learn from experience of doing real tasks beyond the classroom. Students can combine all three components or do activities related to each one of them separately.

Who can apply ?

Applications are open to students from Myanmar seeking pre-university education who meet the following criteria:

- Excellent oral and written English language skills
- High school education in Myanmar or international General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) exam with a grade C or higher or General Education Diploma (GED)
- Aged 16 - 18
- Committed to the social principals and values endorsed by UWC

Applicants with disabilities who are self-sufficient in their everyday needs are encouraged to apply.
