

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION (FAQ)

(FAQs) 

1. Q: Are there any expense for participating in the Walailak University Cultural Camp?

i We support the expenses, such as, accommodation, food, local transportation and etc., EXCEPT insurance and round-trip air-tickets from your home country to Nakhon Si Thammarat province in the below routes;

1. Round-trip international air-ticket from your home country to Thailand, Donmuang or Suvarnabhumi International Airport.
2. One-way domestic air-ticket from Bangkok, Donmuang International Airport to Nakhon Si Thammarat Airport on 24th June 2019.

2. Q: Is it necessary to translate all required documents in English?

i All required documents must be in English.

3. Q: If the applicant does not have the passport, can he/she still apply for the Walailak University Cultural Camp?

i Yes, he/she can using ID card or driving license written in English.

4. Q: Must all required document be sent by both email and post?

i The applicant must submit the required document via the provided online application form only.

5. Is there any quota for each country/university?

i No, the committee will select the applicants from the quality of application such as the quality of video presentation and outstanding educational record.

6. Q: Can the previous camp participants apply for the Walailak University Cultural Camp?

i Yes, they can apply.

7. Q: How many applicants per university can apply for the Walailak University Cultural Camp?

i *The number of applicants is unlimited. But the committee will select only 200 participants among applicants.*

8. Q: Is there any age limit for the applicant?

i *An applicant must be a university student or graduate whose age is not over 30 years old on the camp final date, 1st July 2019.*
