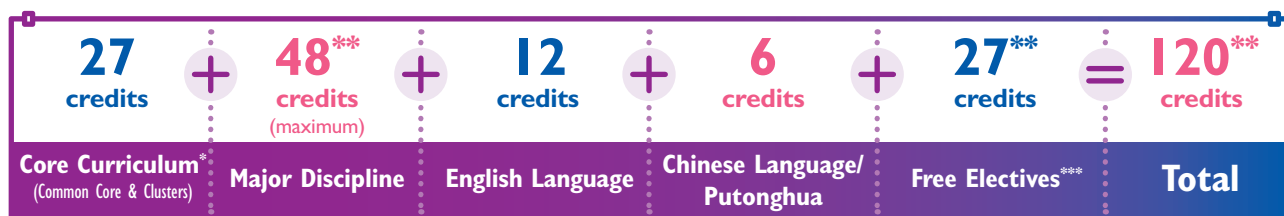

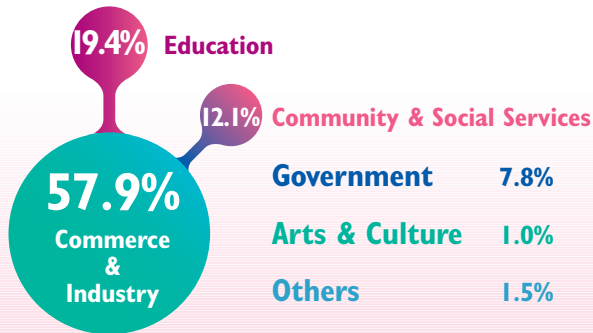
# Career Prospects for Graduates

Overall engagement rate in employment and full-time studies in 2019:

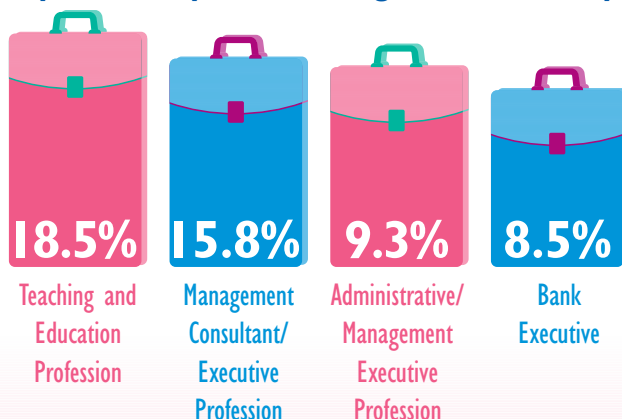

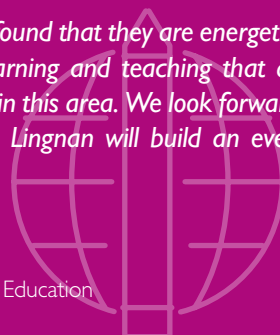

Lingnan offers various scholarships to support high-calibre non-local students to pursue full-time undergraduate studies at the University:

- **Full Scholarship** (covering tuition, hostel and partial academic and living expenses)
- **Half Scholarship**
- **Full-tuition Scholarship**
- **Half-tuition Scholarship**

Each Scholarship is offered on an annual renewable basis and is tenable for a period of up to the normative duration of study, subject to continued outstanding academic performance.
