Admissions Policy

The Graduate School of Kyoto University of Advanced Science (KUAS) seeks applicants with a strong desire to contribute to global society through high-level scholarship and the acquisition of advanced knowledge and expertise in their field of specialization.

The Graduate School of Engineering invites applications from candidates wishing to further develop their specialized technical knowledge and research ability previously acquired in a master's program, to improve their comprehensive understanding of science and technology, to refine their ability to communicate effectively in the research community, and to take the initiative in solving complex and compound problems at the forefront of knowledge. In particular, applicants should:



be eager to tackle complex contemporary issues and find innovative solutions contributing to the future of society from a global perspective;



have obtained a master's degree or equivalent qualification with specialized knowledge in fields related to mechanical and electrical engineering; and



be strongly motivated to confront a multitude of issues by pursuing the highest level of scientific and academic expertise in their chosen field.

Graduation Requirements

To complete the Doctor of Engineering program, students are required to enroll at KUAS for a period of three years, which is equivalent to six full-time semesters of instruction. Students must obtain at least 36 credits and complete a doctoral dissertation that must be approved by the supervisor as well as pass a final examination to be conferred a Doctor of Engineering degree from KUAS.

^{*}The Doctoral Program is a three-year program.

Application Fee

The application fee is 5,000 JPY (non-refundable).

International Payments

In the case of international payments, the application fee is payable with a credit/debit card or other international payment options available through Flywire. Please complete the payment by selecting Flywire at the time of payment. KUAS utilizes Flywire for the processing of our international students' school fees. Flywire allows for payment from most banks, offers competitive exchange rates, and provides 24-hour user support.

If you are from one of the countries indicated below, please give careful attention to the following notes.

China: An invoice issued by KUAS will be required if you choose to pay using <u>an international bank wire</u>. Please contact us for the issuance of an invoice.

Vietnam: An invoice issued by KUAS will be required if you choose to pay using <u>an international bank wire</u>. Please contact us for the issuance of an invoice.

Domestic Payments

In the case of domestic payments, the application fee should be paid through the SB Payment Service. The SB Payment Service allows for credit card and other payment options. Please complete the payment by selecting the SB Payment Service at the time of payment. Domestic payment can not be made through Flywire.

Application Process and Steps:

Step 1. Check your eligibility

- a) Check the academic requirements
- b) Check the English language requirements

Step 2. Obtain supervisor consent

All applicants must obtain prior consent from prospective supervisor before submitting their application. This is to ensure that they can have proper supervision for their desired research topic during their study at KUAS.

Step 3. Prepare the required documents

Application essay, academic transcripts, and other documents

Step 4. Apply online

- a) Complete the Online Application
- b) Upload the required documents
- c) Pay the application fee

Step 5. Take an online interview

Application Eligibility

Applicants MUST fulfill the following requirements of both a) and b):

a) Academic Entry Requirements:

Applicants must have or be expected to have an academic background that satisfies at least one of the following educational criteria by the time of their enrollment at KUAS.

Applicants must:

- have a master's degree or a professional degree;
- have received a degree equivalent to a master's degree or a professional degree outside Japan;
- have received a degree equivalent to a master's degree or a professional degree by completing a program approved by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan at the Japanese campus of an educational institution headquartered overseas;
- have received a degree equivalent to a master's degree or a professional degree through the completion of a distance learning program offered by an overseas school in Japan;
- have received a degree equivalent to a master's degree through the completion of a program at the United Nations University;
- have graduated from university and been engaged in research at a university, research institute, etc. for two years or more. Also, the applicant shall have been recognized by the graduate school as having scholastic ability equivalent to that of a master's graduate;
- have been designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan as meeting requirements; or
- be at least 24 years old and approved through the graduate school's individual screening procedures.

The above criteria are based on the academic requirements stipulated by Japanese educational laws.

Submission of documents to prove at least one of the above educational criteria is required before enrolling at KUAS. If you have other educational qualifications, please consult the International Admissions Office before applying. For more details, please contact the International Admissions Office before sending an application.

b) English Language Requirements:

Applicants must meet the minimum scores stated in the table below. At KUAS' Graduate School of Engineering, English is the language of instruction. The Graduate School does not offer an English as a Second Language (ESL) program. Therefore, all applicants must prove that they can thrive in an English academic environment before enrollment. KUAS accepts the following English proficiency test scores.

EXEMPTIONS: Exemptions are granted to applicants^{*1} with degrees from the U.S., Australia, Canada (except Quebec), New Zealand, Singapore, Ireland, and the United Kingdom (England, Scotland, Northern Ireland, Wales) and/or applicants^{*2} whose first language is English.

*1: If you are an applicant who has an international equivalent degree from a university of recognized standing in a country in which all educational instruction is provided in English or *2: an applicant who has not earned a degree from a university in the above-mentioned English-speaking countries, you MUST submit an English proficiency waiver request along with a letter from one of your college/university teachers who has evaluated your English proficiency. Please upload this letter to your application. Please bear in mind that you will be asked to take an interview in which several teachers will verify your English abilities. If your English proficiency is judged to be insufficient, you may be disqualified from receiving a waiver.

Prior Supervisor Consent

All applicants must contact the International Admissions Office through our Online Application System called The Admissions Office (TAO) in order to obtain prior consent from one prospective supervisor before submitting an application.

Please go to the "Admission & Aid" page on our website and click the "Apply" button in the Graduate section to submit your consent request. You need to upload your CV with specific academic information, a detailed research plan, complete copies of your undergraduate and graduate transcripts, and a list of research achievements (if any). Consent Request Process

Make your request by September 30, 2020 for Early Entry January 17, 2021 for Regular Entry Please fill out the required sections of your TAO request form and upload all necessary documents. After that, please send your request for consent to your prospective supervisor via TAO.

Prospective Supervisor Applicant Review Your prospective supervisor will review your uploaded documents, and make a decision on your candidacy for consent. You may be contacted for consultation if necessary. The results will be posted to applicants' TAO request forms no later than October 7, 2020 for Early Entry or January 24, 2021 for Regular Entry.

Submit Request Documents & Review Result

Once you have confirmed that your prospective supervisor has posted the result to your TAO request form, you must then submit your TAO request form along with the result and all of the documents you prepared for your request for consent via TAO. You are asked to submit this request form within two days upon receipt of the result.

Notifications released No later than October 12, 2020 for Early Entry January 29, 2021 for Regular Entry The International Admissions Office will review your documents and the result from your prospective supervisor. You will be notified of the result of this process by the International Admissions Office via TAO.

Start preparing for application

Applicants who receive prior consent are now qualified to apply for the Doctoral Program at KUAS.

NOTE:

- 01 You are not allowed to ask more than one supervisor for prior consent.
- 702 There is no specific format for research plans, but they should not exceed one sheet of A4 or U.S. letter-sized paper in length.
- *O3* Please upload your list of research achievements if you have any. List the details of publications, presentations, awards, patents, etc.
- O4 You are allowed to submit your request through one TAO account for only one time. If you apply more than once, your request will be automatically rejected.
- 05 Evaluating candidates for consent takes time and may involve additional questions. Therefore, we recommend that you request consent as soon as possible. Once you have applied, please be patient as the professor review your documents. Applicants will be provided with their results no later than October 12, 2020 for Early Entry or January 29, 2021 for Regular Entry. Applicants who have not received prior consent will not be accepted.
- 06 Obtaining consent does NOT guarantee admittance to the KUAS Doctoral Program.

Please upload your photo through TAO. Your photo must be taken within the last three months, showing a portrait (front) view above the chest against a plain background. No caps or hats are allowed.

Summary of research

Required file type: PDF

A typewritten English summary of the applicant's master's thesis must be submitted. Please include a summary of any academic or professional achievements if any. It should not exceed three pages of A4 or U.S. letter-sized paper in length. If you have not yet completed your master's program, a summary of current research will be accepted.

Research plan

Required file type: PDF

Any format is acceptable, however, it should not exceed five pages of A4 or U.S. letter-sized paper in length. This research plan should be typed in English.

Application essay (400 to 500 words)

Required file type: PDF

Please write a short essay in English on the topic of your reason(s) for applying to the Doctoral Program at KUAS and upload it to TAO. In your essay, you should also describe what you expect to achieve in this program as well as your subjects of specialty. There are no specific requirements for the essay's formatting, spacing, etc.

Official academic transcripts from all colleges and/or universities attended ◆

Please upload your official academic transcripts and certified English translation if needed through TAO. <u>Transcripts should include all courses, credits, grades, and term information along with details about the grading system which is typically displayed on the back of the transcript.</u>

Please be advised that you will be required to physically mail us your OFFICIAL transcripts when KUAS so requests. These official transcripts must be sealed in an envelope.

*Applicants who have not yet graduated from graduate school are required to submit their most current academic transcripts available. Final transcripts will be required at the time of enrollment.

Evidence of English language proficiency (TOEFL iBT/IELTS/PTE)

Applicants whose native language is not English are required to provide proof of their English proficiency. Please submit a valid score* from one of KUAS' acceptable standardized tests. Please refer to Page 8 for details about each test and applying for exemption.

Test scores must be sent directly from the testing agency. Applicants must request that their scores be sent directly to KUAS (or register on the testing agency's website). It may take up to 4 to 6 weeks for your results to arrive at KUAS. Therefore, we highly recommend that you take these tests well in advance.

-For TOEFL iBT, The KUAS institution code is C468.

*Test scores must be no more than two years old on their day of arrival at KUAS for them to be considered valid for admission.

A Letter of recommendation

Required file type: PDF

KUAS requires at least one letter of recommendation from an educator. It should be from your supervisor in a master's program.

The recommendation letter should be directly uploaded to your TAO application by your recommender. Please send your request for recommendation to them via TAO. Any format of recommendation letter is acceptable. However, this letter must be typed in English. Please be aware that it is your responsibility to ensure that KUAS receives this letter before the online application closing date.

Please note that KUAS may contact the recommender for more details.

Please scan or photocopy the photo ID page of your passport and upload it to your TAO application for identification purposes. The uploaded scan copy must be in color and clearly show your photo, name, and passport number. Applicants who do not have a valid passport should submit a photocopy of another form of government-issued photo ID. Applicants with neither of these forms of ID are still eligible to apply. However, they will be required to submit a passport photocopy before enrollment.

Information Regarding Financial Status

(Only for applicants without a valid Japanese residence status)

On your TAO application, please submit the name of the person who will be the source of your financial support while at KUAS and your relationship with them. Additionally, you must state their income and bank account balance to demonstrate their financial capacity to support your study at KUAS.

You will be asked to submit the necessary documents to certify their financial capacity during your admission procedures.

Online Interview

At KUAS, we value each applicant's passion, enthusiasm, and independent thinking. In order to learn more about applicants, we ask all applicants to take an online interview with us. All interviews will be conducted via an online video chatroom, so it is not necessary for applicants to travel to Japan. Please ensure that you have access to a web-based video chat platform. During an interview, applicants are allowed to share supplemental materials to present them.

KUAS will send you an online interview invitation with detailed information, including an interview schedule by December 4, 2020 (Early Entry applicants) or March 24, 2021 (Regular Entry applicants). The exact date and time of your interview will be determined by the University. Please check your email / TAO account regularly for these notifications. Interviews will be held in November and December, and March, respectively.

Screening Methods

The screening of applications will be conducted based on the documents submitted and the results of the online interview. These processes will take place in a proper manner and each application will be reviewed fairly and with due care by our faculty members.

Announcement of Results

Results will be announced through TAO on the designated result announcement days. Please note that KUAS cannot answer any inquiries regarding results.

Scholarships

Scholarships are provided to a limited number of outstanding students based on a number of factors including but not limited to academic ability, scholastic achievements, social contributions, application contents and others.

KUAS offers two types of scholarships: the Super KUAS-E Scholarships and the KUAS-E Scholarships. They are competitive and are made available to students who demonstrate high academic performance. While at KUAS, the academic performance of each scholarship recipient will be **reviewed** to decide whether their scholarship will be renewed. Therefore, students who are awarded scholarships are expected to maintain consistently high academic performance and act as a role model for other students. If a scholarship recipient behaves inappropriately or does anything to damage the reputation of KUAS, **their scholarships will be revoked.**

Applicants who wish to apply for a scholarship must indicate their intent on the appropriate section of their TAO application. All information provided during the application process will be evaluated, and scholarship selection results will be released together with application results.

Student Accommodations

At KUAS, students can choose to live in an on-campus dormitory or in private accommodation outside of the campus. If you prefer private accommodation, KUAS can assist you in finding housing. Prospective students who receive an offer from KUAS can submit a request for on-campus housing. Due to limited on-campus dormitory availability, a lottery will be held if applications exceed the maximum number of residents. Furthermore, all dorm residence terms are limited to one year, after which students are required to seek off-campus housing. Once students have rented a dormitory room, they are obligated to stay until the end of their rental contract (one year).

On-campus dormitory accommodation fees

All students who live in the on-campus dormitory are required to pay the fees below, regardless of what financial aid they may receive. These fees cover a furnished dormitory room, utilities, and two meals every weekday (breakfast and dinner).



Insurance

Declining Enrollment

If you decide not to enroll at KUAS after all admission procedures have been performed, you must submit the designated statement by May 14, 2021 (Early Entry applicants) or June 4, 2021 (Regular Entry applicants) so that your second payment can be refunded (the admission fee can NOT be refunded). 

KUAS will take the necessary procedures to ensure that the Japanese Immigration Bureau issues you a Certificate of Eligibility (COE). This COE can be used to obtain your visa at the Japanese embassy or consulate general in your country or region.

To apply for a COE:



Applicants must begin applying for a student visa as soon as receiving their COE. Specific details will be provided with the release of admission results.
